Teacher Website Interface

Below are some components that can be listed on a teacher website.

(1) About the Teacher

Include an About the Teacher page. Upload a photo and provide general information about yourself.

(2) Parent News

Include a Parent News page and post any important announcements for parents or upcoming events/projects taking place in your classes.

(3) Online Course

Include a link to your Online Moodle Course where you will be posting classroom activities and resources for students.

(4) Parent Letter

Include a Parent Letter page. This should resemble the first day letter that you send home to parents. Don't forget to include your website address on the letter.

(5) Syllabus

Include a detailed Syllabus about your class. Include information about major units of study, how students will be graded, etc.

(6) Calendar

Include a Calendar page. Items such as your Conference Period, Tutorial Days/Times, etc. can be posted on the calendar.

(7) Welcome/Class Description

Include your Name and the Name of your Class. Also include a Welcome Message below this, along with a brief description and the goals of the course.
